Natural Disaster

Extreme drought, earthquakes, floods, and other devastating effects of climate change



Failing Infrastructure

Lack of communication structures, crumbling roadways, and poor public services like healthcare and education



Lack of Resources

Lack of access to clean water, extreme hunger, severe economic disparity, and widespread poverty

What does that mean?

Millions of people are left in crisis.

Governments are not legally bound to grant asylum to individuals fleeing their home countries for humanitarian reasons despite the imminent threat to their safety.

Each nation is free to establish their own regulations regarding the acceptance of refugees under humanitarian conditions, meaning many sufferers are turned away.

Project Objective

Evoke compassion for asylum-seekers by demonstrating the relationship between those rejected or awaiting decision with the current failing state of their home country.

Project Solution

Create an interactive light installation displaying asylum-seeker and failure state data. Allow the user to manipulate the display through an iPad application and to explore detailed information further explaining a country's health within specific factors.

UN Refugee Agency

Maintains a detailed, extensive global database of population statistics of refugees, asylum-seekers, internally displaced persons, returned refugees, returned IDPs, stateless persons, and other persons of concerns receiving assistance from the UN.

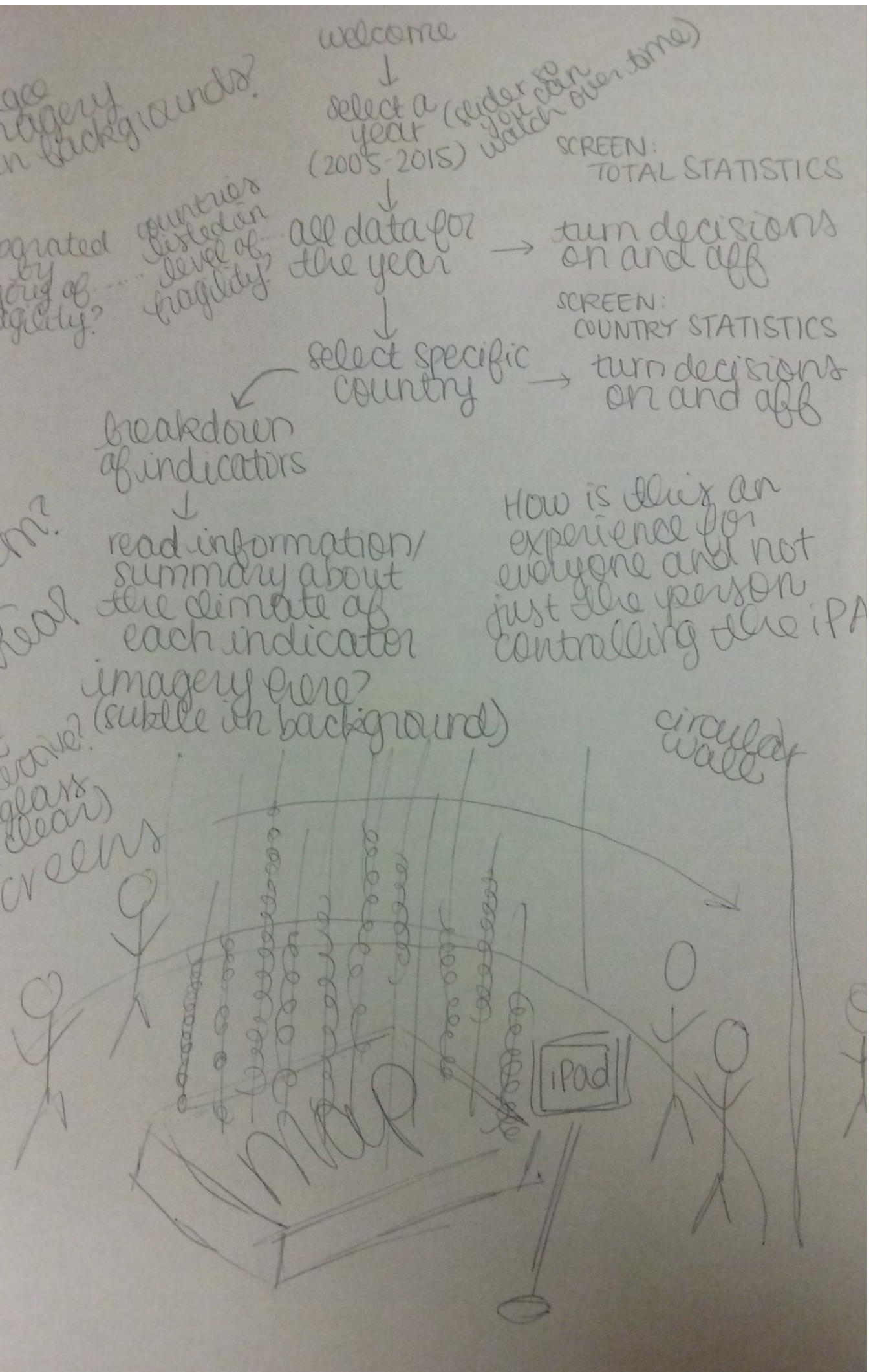
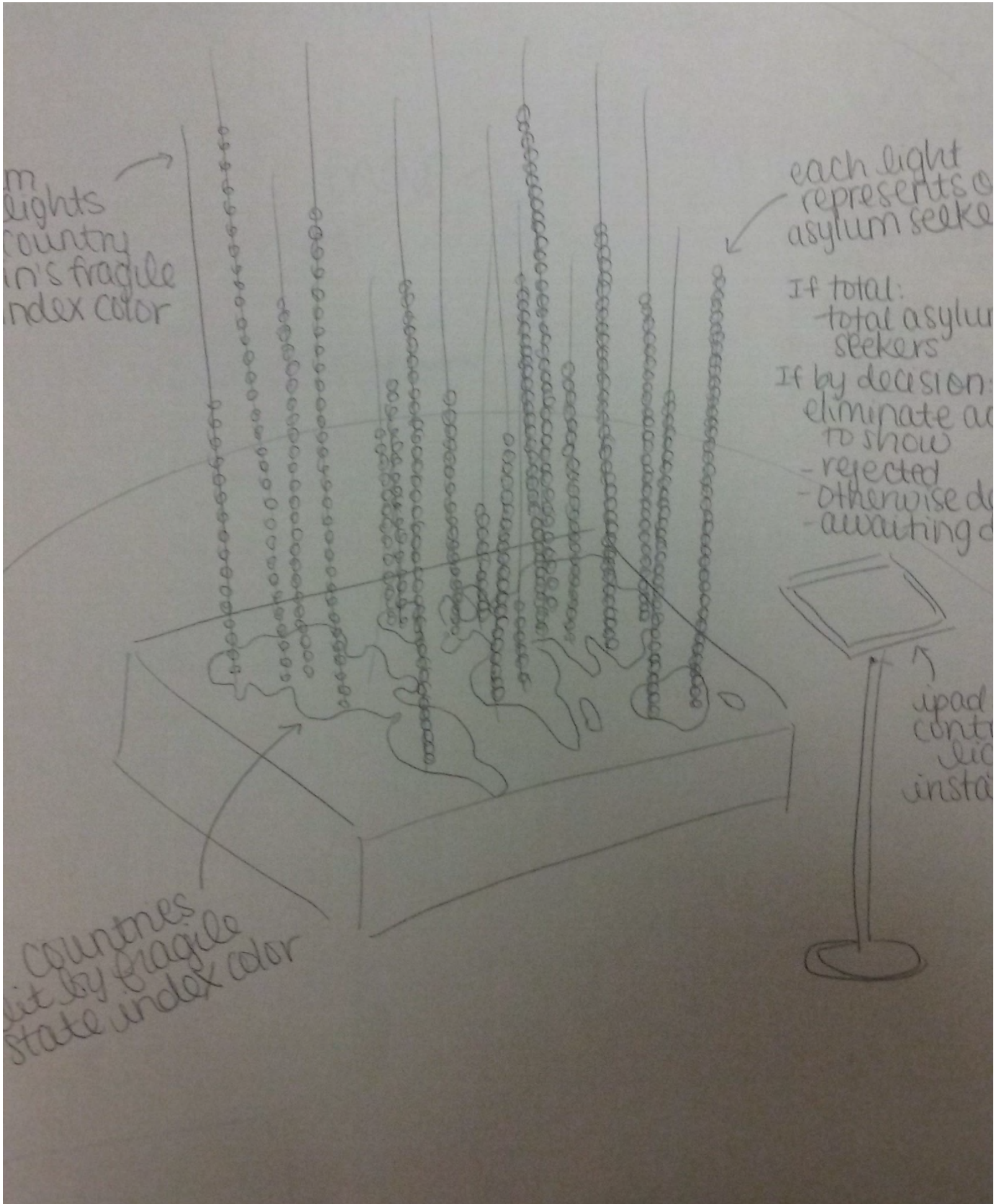

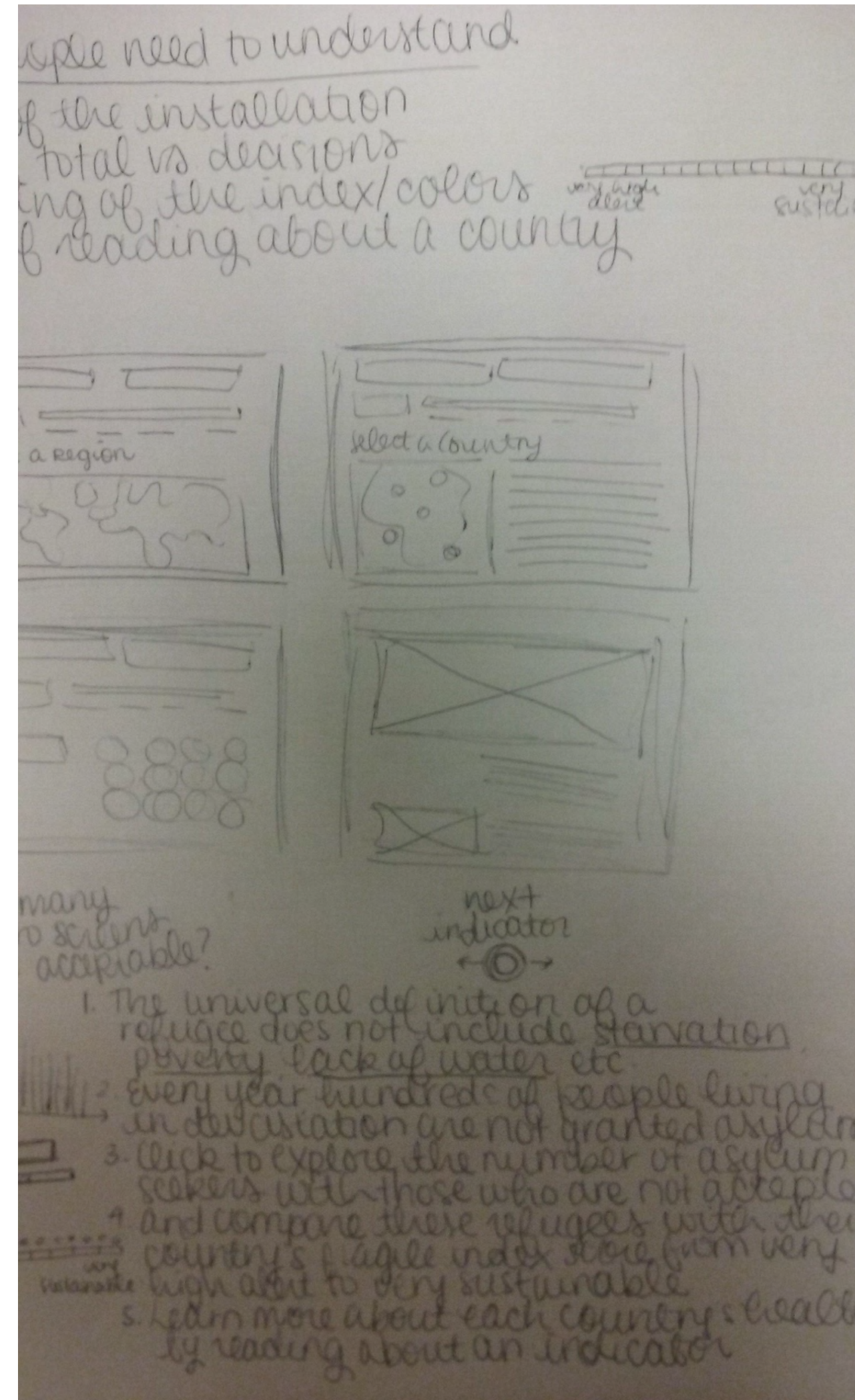
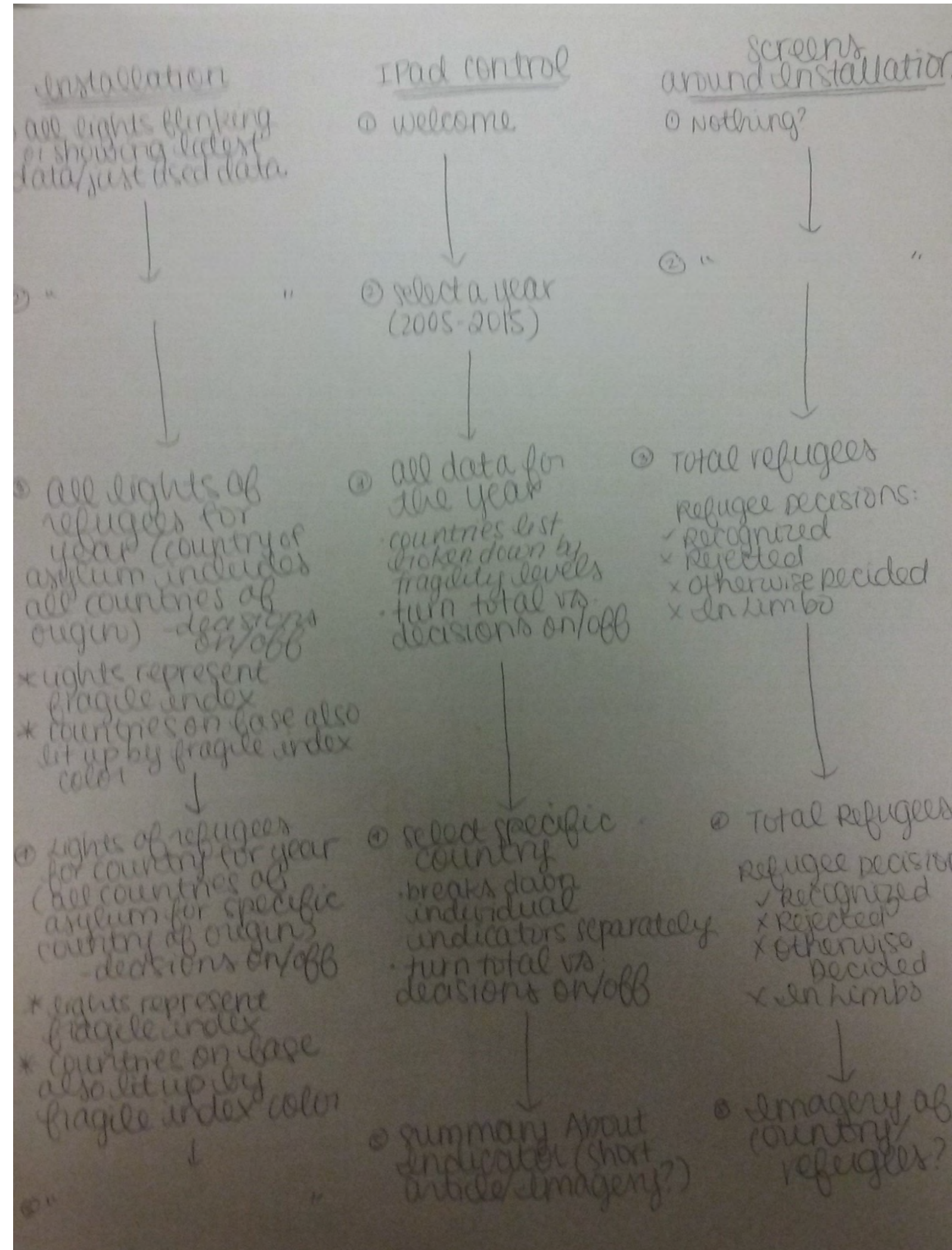
Fund for Peace

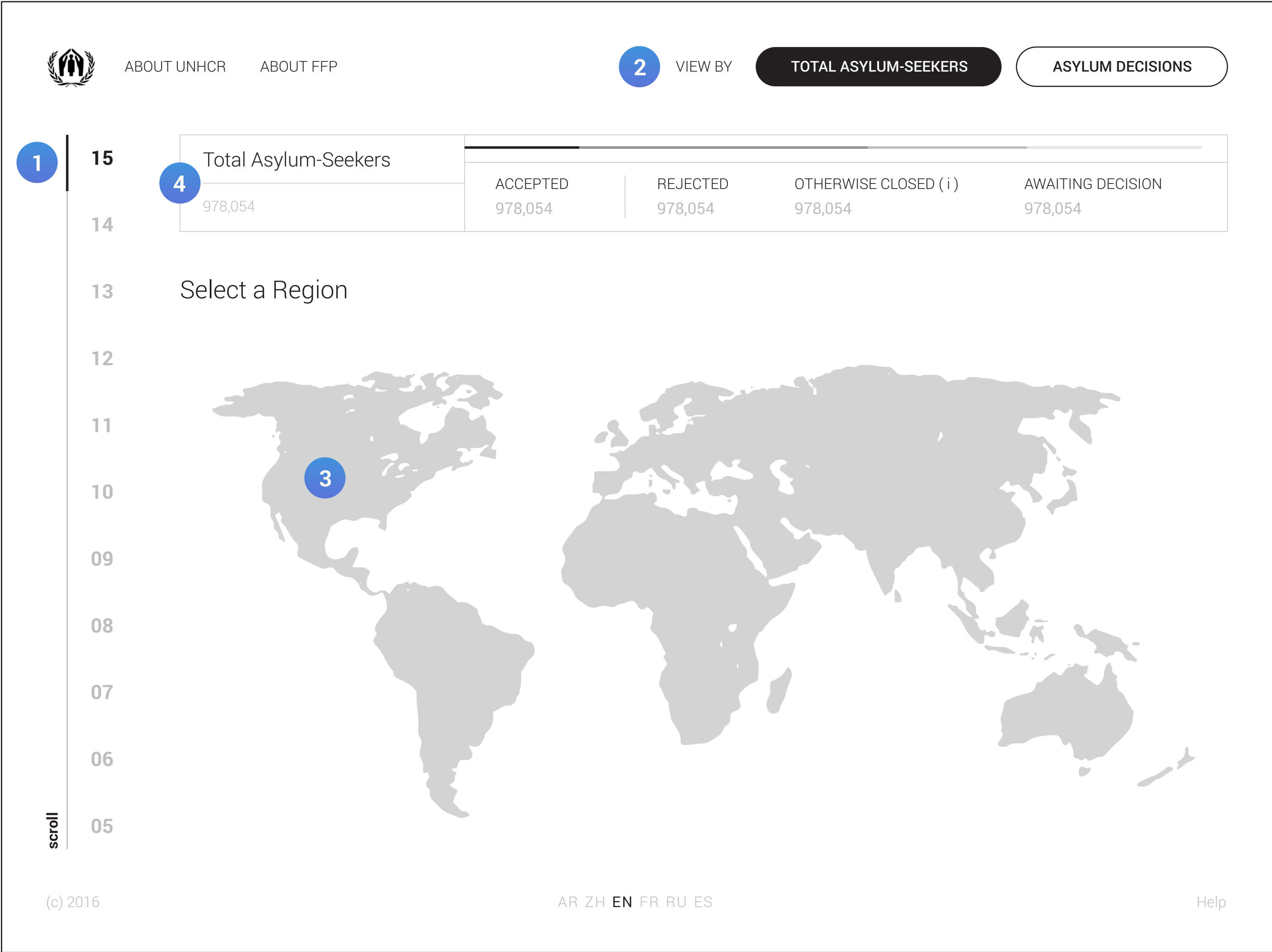

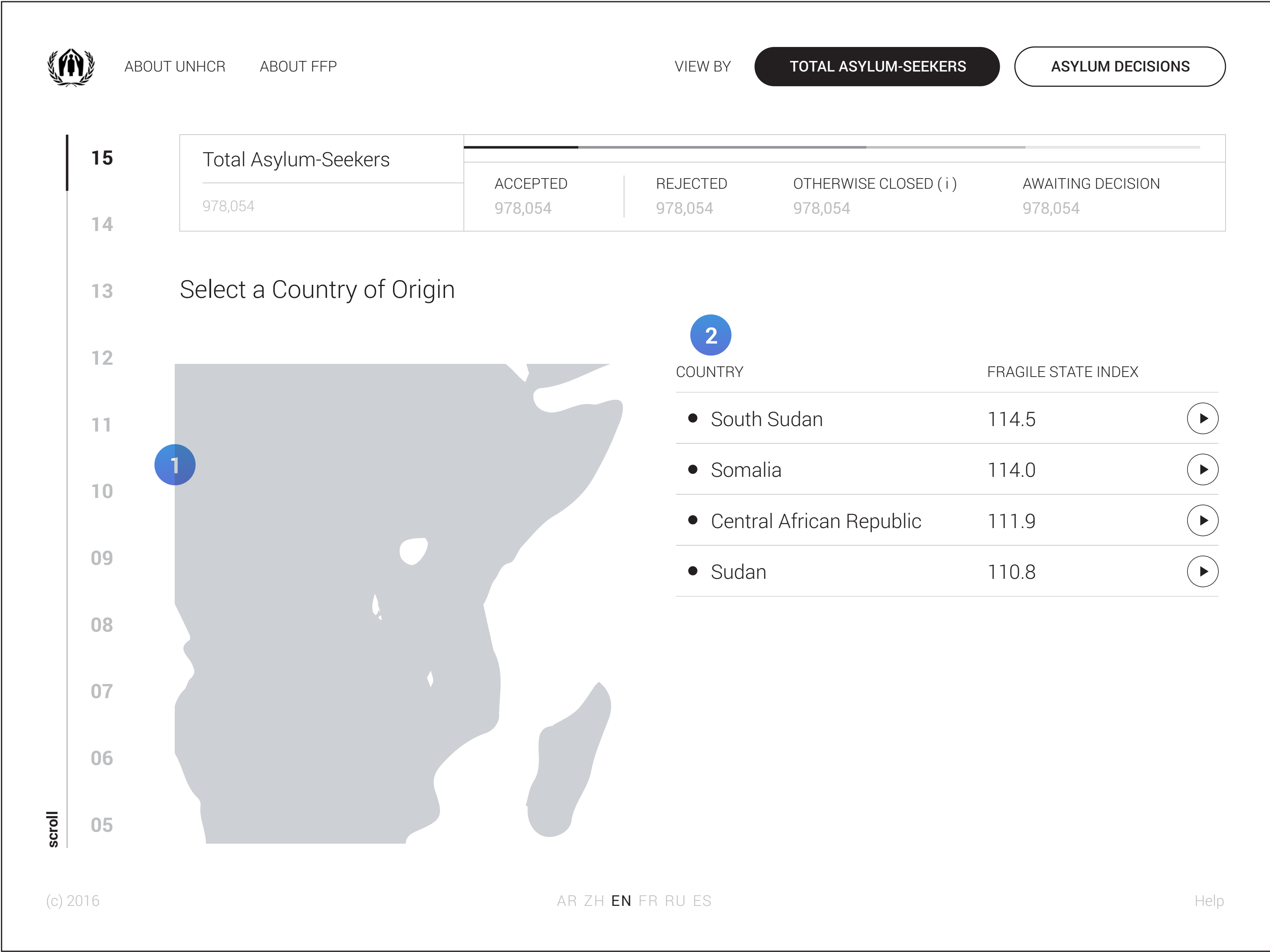
